Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be current postsecondary undergraduate or graduate students who are pursuing a degree in one of the following fields of study:
 - Computer Engineering
 - o Computer Science
 - Electrical Engineering
 - Network Engineering
 - o Telecommunications (at the graduate-level only)
- Plan to enroll part-time (at least six credits) or full-time in undergraduate or graduate study at an accredited two- or four-year college or university school for the entire 2019-2020 academic year.
- Have a minimum grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (or its equivalent).
- Each recipient of the scholarship agrees to allow the use of his or her biographical and academic information in publications of the University and NANOG respectively.
